Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All external transfer applications to Scariff Community College for the school year 25/25 will only be accepted after 28/04/2025 and the closing date for receipt of applications is 21/06/2025. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

Please be reminded that, in line with the school's Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply. Therefore, if a student is seeking a place in the Special Class and is not successful in a given academic year or is on a waiting list for this year, a new application must be made for the following year.
